

Personal, social & emotional development.

- *'My Life'; Talking about changes in own life since birth - To talk to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions / describe self in positive terms & talk about abilities.
- *Home corner vet; To demonstrate friendly behaviour / taking account of one another's ideas about how to organise their activity.

Physical development.

- *Sports day practices; To experiment with different ways of moving.

Communication & Language.

- * 'My Life'; Talking about changes in own life since birth - To answer how & why questions about their experiences & in response to events, listening & responding to ideas expressed by others. To use past, present & future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened.
- *Vet role play; To use language to imagine & recreate roles & experiences, introducing a storyline into their play.

Literacy.

- *RWI - kubfe / 'La-la-la' Set 1 sounds / 'In the sun' Set 2 sounds / 'Fun at the fair' Set 2&3 sounds; To link sounds to letters, naming & sounding the letters of the alphabet / To begin to read words & simple sentences / To use clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly & in sequence.
- *First Call; To develop anticipation skills - Lift the flap / puppets.
- *To listen to & talk about religious stories involving babies.
- *'My Life'; To sequence photos of their development adding captions / short sentences to describe them.

Mathematics.

- *'My life'; To use every day language related to time - Changes over time in own life as they have grown / developed & sequencing activities relating to a farmer's day - introduce O'Clock to some.
- *Vet role play; Recording numbers accurately on prescriptions, including two digit numbers to 100 - To record, using marks they can interpret & explain.

Expressive Arts & Design.

- *Making farm animal masks; To experiment to create different textures / select tools & techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials.
- *Animal sounds game; To explore the different sounds of animals / instruments.
- *Vet & outdoor farm role play; To play cooperatively in a group to develop & act out a narrative.

Understanding the world.

- *'My life'; To remember & talk about significant events in their own experience. To develop an understanding of growth, decay & changes over time.
- *Vet role play; To show care & concern for living things / an understanding of growth & decay.
- *Sun safety; To talk about aspects of their own environment, recognising seasonal changes & their impact.
